This is a great way to introduce children to scuba diving in a pool in less than two metres. It's fun, easy and safe.

The Fun Part

Children should be comfortable in the water, but they don't have to be super swimmers. With youngsters in mind, the maximum depth is only 2 metres.

- Typical sessions last about an hour (sign up, gear up and fun included)

- Take their first breath underwater
- Learn about and use scuba diving equipment made for children - not adults

Are you a certified diver, but you haven't managed to dive for a while - 6 months, one year or even years! Are you looking to refresh your dive skills and knowledge? If you answered yes to any of these questions, then the Refresher Course is for you.

First, you will review the safety information you learned during your initial training under the supervision of an Instructor. Then, you head to confined water to practice some of the fundamental scuba skills. There is also a supervised open water dive and the instructor will document this in your logbook.

After your Refresher Course, you will be prepared to get back into diving or continue your diving education.
